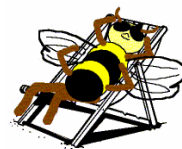

Roles Minimum Male roles = 0. Minimum Female roles = 6. Minimum total with doubling = 20. Minimum total without doubling = 30. No chorus.

Runtime Around 30 minutes.

Music Sheet music for 10 songs and 2 instrumentals is supplied with the Producer's Copy of the script.

Style Short one-act musical play for (young) children.

Outline A school child gets his wish to see the Romanian child open the present he is sending. A Christmas play for infant schools.

A Grimm Night for Hans Christian Andersen (Musical)

Author Sue Gordon

Roles Minimum Male roles = 8. Minimum Female roles = 10. Minimum total with doubling = 23. Minimum total without doubling = 40. No chorus.

Runtime Around 90 minutes.

Music Sheet music for 7 original songs and 3 pieces of incidental music is provided with the producer's copy of the script.

Style Comic retelling of fairytales as a musical play. Many scenes, but using the same few pieces of 'set furniture'. Simple props.

Outline Hans Christian Andersen gets an unexpected visit from the Brothers Grimm - who seem to be upset over the matter of stealing story lines. A competition ensues, with characters from Andersen and Grimm stories taking the stage - often in unexpected ways.

Style A light musical for young children. Basic sets.

Outline A school class write Christmas letters to Santa, and we discover that they are dealt with by Mrs. Santa and a bunch of fractious elves.

Style One-act large-cast musical (probably a whole school class) for kids. A comedy with a strong ecological message. Little in the way of set or props - mostly characters instead of props! (The Producer's copy of the script includes costume suggestions!)

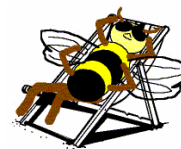
Outline Life on an overspill rubbish dump takes a philosophical turn, with items of garbage asking 'why are we here?' - and making a song and dance about it!

- Author** Sue Gordon
- Roles** Minimum Male roles = 0. Minimum Female roles = 0. Minimum total with doubling = 2. Minimum total without doubling = 5. No chorus.
- Runtime** Around 60 minutes.
- Music** Piano and vocal scores for eight original songs are supplied with the Producer's copy of the script.
- Style** One-act musical for a small cast (designed to be played by an adult touring company to school audiences)
- Outline** Life on an overspill rubbish dump takes a philosophical turn, with items of garbage asking 'why are we here?' - and making a song and dance about it!
- Plus** The following additional items are available (at extra cost) to go with this script: ** A 'backing track CD' with arrangements of all the songs from the show
** Soundtrack CD - vocal performances of all the songs from the show

A Musical Mother Goose

- Author** Gerald P. Murphy
- Roles** Minimum Male roles = 2. Minimum Female roles = 2. Minimum total with doubling = 9. Minimum total without doubling = 21. Chorus.
- Runtime** Around 20 minutes.

- Style** Musical play (a series of linked sketches) for young children. Minimal set requirements
- Outline** This is 'Mother Goose' in the American sense - a vehicle for stories and rhymes, rather than the English sense of a particular story about a character called Mother Goose. (For anyone curious about this difference, the American sense is taken from Charles Perrault's collection of fairy stories '*Les Contes de ma mère l'Oye*' - literally '*The Tales of my mother the Goose*' whilst the English version is the tale of the Goose that laid the golden eggs - generally given the English pantomime treatment, for which see elsewhere on this site.) Anyway, in this case it's a collection of original stories and songs based on nursery stories and characters.

A New You

- Author** Wesley A. Knoch
- Roles** Minimum Male roles = 8. Minimum Female roles = 8. Minimum total with doubling = 24. Minimum total without doubling = 30. Chorus.

- Music** Piano and Vocal sheet music for nine original songs is provided with the Producer's Copy of the script
- Style** One act musical comedy play - set in the studio of a TV make-over show complete with cheesy presenters and sponsorship jingles.
- Outline** A Nasally over-blessed heroine (Miss Nodda Tragtiff) takes part in a reality Makeover show, only to find that the New You promised has caused her to lose her old friends and only gained her fleeting popularity with new people. She comes to understand that real beauty comes from within, and true friends aren't swayed by appearance.

- Music** A Piano and Vocal score for all the 27 songs (with 22 orchestral pieces scored for multiple instruments) is provided with the Producer's Copy of the script. The scores have deliberately kept away from extremes of vocal range.
- Style** Operetta, setting the Charles Dickens story to the music of Arthur Sullivan.
- Outline** A traditional re-telling of Dickens' classic story of the redemption of a miser, using pieces from many of Gilbert and Sullivan's musicals with original lyrics.

Runtime Around 30 minutes.

Music Sheet music (piano and vocal) for five songs and two instrumentals is provided with the Producer's Copy of the script.

Style Simple one-act musical for kids - a prologue and four of Aesop's fables.
(A version of this collection of tales is available without the songs as *Aesop's Fables II*.)

Outline A group of mice are delighted by their plan for constraining the local cat - until it comes to executing the plan. Meanwhile, a lion falls in love, a boy ruins his chance of promotion in the shepherding business, and a fox tries to make the most of a fashion disaster.
(They all make a song and dance of it!)

Anna of Nazareth

Runtime Around 50 minutes.

Music Piano and vocal score for 16 songs supplied with the producer's copy of the script.

Style One-act musical for performance by teenagers, young adults or a mixture of adults and teenagers. No specific set requirements.

Outline Christmas musical telling the story of Mary from her betrothal to Joseph up to the birth of Jesus (roughly Matthew 1, 18-25, Luke 1, 26-38 and Luke 2, 1-7). Told from the point of view of a teenage girl, Anna, a jealous friend of Mary. It brings out the difficulty of Mary's situation within her community, but the resolution is joyous and uplifting.

Around the World in Eighty Days

Music Piano and vocal score for seventeen songs and nineteen pieces of incidental music is provided with the producer's copy of the script.

Style Full-length school musical based on Jules Verne's novel. By the nature of the story, there are a lot of locations, but these can be presented in as simple or complex a way as you please.

Outline Phileas Fogg accepts a wager to travel around the World in Eighty days. Armed with only Passepartout (his trusty French manservant) and pursued by a detective, he sets out, venturing via Egypt, India (where he acquires a princess!), Japan and the USA.

Roles Minimum Male roles = 5. Minimum Female roles = 10. Minimum total with doubling = 16. Minimum total without doubling = 16. Chorus.

Runtime Around 50 minutes.

Music Musical scores for 13 songs are included with the Producer's copy of the script.

Style One-act comedy musical for kids. Minimal set requirements, simple props.

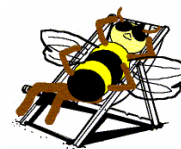

Style Musical set in and around a casino. Songs in various styles including swing, ragtime, tango and jazz-funk.

Outline Gambler Ryan Thomas brings his naive English friend Jack to a casino. Whilst discovering the perils of the Blackjack table, Jack falls for Alice, the pianist with the house band. Unfortunately, Alice is already spoken for by Louis Diaz, known as Mr. Big Shot for his reputation as a lucky gambler. Luck which Jack decides to test - with unforeseen consequences, for this is the 1950s and Las Vegas gambling is dominated by the mob...

Style Simple musical for kids - an excuse to dip into a few historical topics!

Outline Billionaire Gil Bates is a smart man when it comes to computers, but has trouble with remembering basic history and culture. He and his wife hatch a plan: combine a group of teachers and Gil's love of musical theatre, and present some of history's greatest moments in musical form!

Style One-act musical play for performance by children or a mixture of adults and children. Very simple set and no specific requirements for props.

Outline A review and also a revue! A series of linked musical sketches presenting an investigation of issues surrounding bullying at school, covering reasons for bullying and approaches to dealing with it.

Style Comedy for kids in two short acts. No specific staging requirements, with some aspects of set and sound effects being provided by the on-stage chorus.

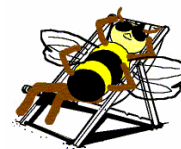
Outline Miguel de Cervantes's famed tale of the eccentric knight and his inept but trusting squire. Alonso Quixano is obsessed with tales of chivalry. So much so that he believes himself to be a knight - Don Quixote - and he sets out to seek adventure, with a peasant farmer, Sancho Panza, as his squire.

- Style* Musical Gothic horror Melodrama!
- Outline* A faithful translation of Bram Stoker's vampire classic to the musical stage, rendered in a melodramatic style!

Drama Club Must Die!

- Author* Gerald P. Murphy
- Roles* Minimum Male roles = 6. Minimum Female roles = 13. Minimum total with doubling = 26. Minimum total without doubling = 35. No chorus.
- Runtime* Around 70 minutes.
- Music* Complete set of original lyrics and musical arrangements based on traditional tunes supplied with the Producer's Copy of the script.
- Style* Musical play set in an American High School (but could be played by younger children). Simple sets.
- Outline* The High School budget needs to be cut. The drama club is under threat from the unsympathetic principal. Can the Drama Club save themselves by creating a production of The Wizard of Oz from scratch?

- Outline* Hera, the queen of the gods, is furious when she discovers that her husband Zeus has been unfaithful, and she takes it out on the object of his affections, the articulate Echo. Echo falls for the handsome Narcissus, but she cannot make him understand because of Hera's curse, which confines Echo to repeating the words of others, and meanwhile Narcissus is in love with his own reflection. (Not a happy lot, the Ancient Greeks!)

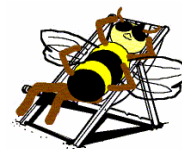
Esther

- Author* Richard Cowling
- Roles* Minimum Male roles = 5. Minimum Female roles = 3. Minimum total with doubling = 22. Minimum total without doubling = 32. Chorus.
- Runtime* Around 90 minutes.
- Music* The producer's copy of the script comes with piano and vocal scores for 16 songs, one instrumental and 15 scene-change pieces. (A conductor's score and band parts are available as an optional extra.)
- Style* Full-length Musical based on the biblical story of Esther. Designed as a school musical, could equally well be done by an adult or mixed company.
- Outline* King Xerxes of Persia marries Esther, a Jewish orphan who has been brought up by her uncle, Mordecai. Haman, the chief minister of Xerxes court insists that everyone bow down to him. When Mordecai refuses to do so, Haman flies into a rage and plans to kill Mordecai, and all the Jewish people in the kingdom. Mordecai calls upon Esther for help, but this means she must confront the mighty Xerxes...

Style Gothic horror musical comedy!

Outline If Mary Shelley had written a version of Frankenstein for children, this is how she might have approached it - as a heartwarming family musical, filled with mad scientists, misbegotten creatures and an angry mob!

On a rainy night when the power is out, a father tells his son the story of Frankenstein, and we are transported to Victor Frankenstein's Laboratory with Mary Shelly singing of the creation of the creature. We meet the creature, his bride and a croud of villagers, led by the rabble rouser Frau Gribble, whipped into a frenzy and go in search of 'the Monster'. Eventually, they come to realise that he was just misunderstood!

Greece! - The Musical

Author Sue Gordon

Roles Minimum Male roles = 2. Minimum Female roles = 1. Minimum total with doubling = 7. Minimum total without doubling = 15. Chorus.

Runtime Around 45 minutes.

Music Sheet music for six original songs supplied with the Producer's copy of the script.

Style Modern version of Ancient Greek drama with a humorous interpretation of Greek myths and legends. No set requirements, few props. The text is identical to Greece! - The Play, except that some of the chants are replaced by songs.

Outline There's trouble on Mount Olympus - the boiler has stopped working and Zeus isn't getting any hot water. Zeus is in a temper and Dionysus has a hangover. It's up to Hera to sort things out by calling for Heracles, the odd job man of Ancient Greece...

Gruff - The Musical

Style Very short musical play for kids. Single set - a troll bridge.

Outline Overweight goats meet greedy troll. The troll's dinner menu changes when Billy Goat butts in.

Hamelin Rats - The Musical

Style Short one-act musical for kids. The story of the Pied Piper of Hamelin told as a simple verse play with six songs. Minimal set requirements.

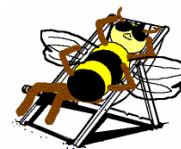
Outline Rats are taking over the rich town of Hamelin, so when an eccentrically dressed stranger offers to drive them away, the Mayor offers to heap him with gold. However, when the rats have disappeared, so has the Mayor's promise, till the stranger reminds the town of his musical prowess.

- Roles* Minimum Male roles = 5. Minimum Female roles = 3. Minimum total with doubling = 12. Minimum total without doubling = 16. Chorus.
- Runtime* Around 40 minutes.
- Music* Sheet music (piano and vocal) for the five songs is supplied with the producer's copy of the script.
- Style* Shakespeare's Hamlet retold in modern (American) English, with more jokes than the original. In a normal tragedy, at the end, everyone dies. This is a musical - at the end, everyone sings.
- Outline* Prince Hamlet's father reappears as a ghost to demand revenge for his murder. The prince vacillates, arranges a play to trap the murderer, and finally chooses to fight.
- Plus* The following additional items are available (at extra cost) to go with this script: ** A 'rehearsal CD' with piano arrangements of all the songs from the show

Hansel and Gretel - A Short Musical

- Author* Gerald P. Murphy
