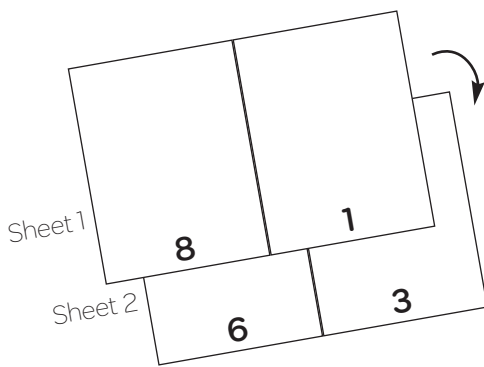
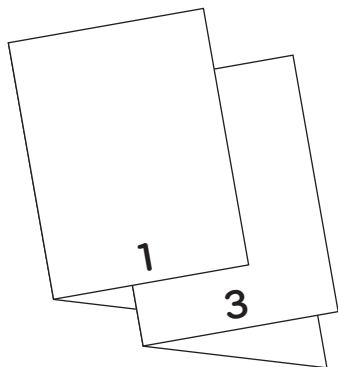


How to put together your Kid's Fun Packs for retail!

1. Print out the sheets on a black-and-white or colour printer (depending on which version you purchased). Print on A4 (orientation: landscape), and make sure that sheet 2 is printed on the back of sheet 1, and sheet 4 is printed on the back of sheet 3. Check that none of the pages are printed upside down before you do a lot of them!

2. When printed, place sheet 1 face up (cover showing) onto sheet 2 (page numbered 3 should be face up!)



3. Then fold the two sheets into an eight page booklet, with page numbered 1 on the front and page numbered 8 on the back! The centre pages should be numbered 4 and 5.

4. If your budget stretches to it, staple them together along the spine for a more professional look, or if you are a really wealthy society hire squirrels to hold the two sheets together (but remember to stock acorns in the bar or there may be trouble!).

5. To create a larger version, print the pages at 141% scaling onto A3 (orientation: landscape) paper, then follow steps 2 through 4!

Software Tip: Occasionally, some printers do not like to print out PDF files! If you have a problem, the Acrobat program has an option in the print menu called "Print as Image". Use this option and the issue should be resolved!
